

Conditions of Entry – COVID-19

3rd November 2021

The following outlines the Conditions of Entry to ensure that the Donvale Tennis Club (**the Club**) can operate in a safe and welcoming manner within a COVID-19 environment. The Conditions of Entry have been established in conjunction with the Club's COVIDSafe plans for tennis activity and hospitality, and comply with Manningham Council (**Council**), Sports & Recreation Victoria and Tennis Victoria guidelines. It also addresses what will take place when there are breaches or a positive Covid-19 test result of members, guests or their families.

Main Points:

- The Club facilities are available for tennis activity ONLY. This includes competition, coaching, social play and spectating.
- **MANDATORY:** All persons entering facilities must use QR check-in system.
- Vaccination is not required (unless you are a coach or contractor).
- Competition and Organised Social Play allowed.
- Spectators are permitted up to 30 people per group.
- Face Masks are required indoors (unless you have a lawful reason not to).
- **Clubhouse:** can be accessed for use of toilets and change rooms ONLY.

NOTE: Using the clubhouse for any other purpose requires full vaccination and subsequent record keeping and hence we have decided not to open further at this stage.

Conditions of Entry

1. All persons must abide the main points listed above, plus;
2. Any person MUST NOT enter the Club if they have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days or have mild flu-like symptoms.
3. All persons entering Club facilities must provide their contact details either via QR tracking system or log book. Details are available at entrance gates.
4. Social distancing (at least 1.5 metres) must always be observed. No physical contact with others, including handshakes and high fives.
5. All persons must observe good hygiene practises. Please sanitise your hands before and after play and as needed (bring your own sanitiser). Cover your coughs/sneezes with your elbow.
6. All persons must observe current govt requirements for carrying and wearing of face masks.
7. The Club has implemented strict disinfecting procedures which MUST be followed – details at each court entrance.
8. CLUBHOUSE: any person opening the clubhouse for toilet access (convenor / coach) is responsible for either disinfecting it afterwards or passing that responsibility to another person.
9. Bring your own full water bottle. Water fountains will not be available. There is a tap at the rear of the clubhouse for refills.
10. Major government fines apply to individuals and the Club for non-compliance with government regulations.

Breach of Conditions

1. Where there is a minor breach of the above requirements the person will be warned by the committee, asked to stop their match or leave the courts and court area immediately.
2. For repeat breaches or more serious breaches the person will be asked to stop their match or leave the courts and court area immediately. Further, a specially formed COVID-19 Breach Committee will consider details of the breach and determine the appropriate action to be taken. Such action can include suspension or cancellation of a membership.
3. If a person presents to the Club with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 they will be asked to return home or provided with assistance to seek medical treatment.

Positive Test to COVID-19

1. If any player/spectator or member of their family tests positive to COVID-19 the committee will ascertain if and when they were most recently at the courts.
2. The Club will close the courts and clubhouse immediately unless it can be definitively confirmed the person who tested positive has not been at the courts in the prior 14 days.
3. All members will be notified of a positive testing, via their nominated email address.
4. If a recent guest or parent/family member of an adult or child who has played or been coached at the club in the past 14 days tests positive to COVID-19 the courts and clubhouse will be immediately closed and all members will be notified.
5. In the above situations, the Club will contact and liaise with Department of Human Services, Manningham Council and Tennis Victoria.
6. The Club will undertake any other actions as required by government or Tennis Victoria.
7. Any person who has tested positive or shown COVID-19 symptoms will be able to return to playing or to the courts if they have a relevant medical clearance certificate.
